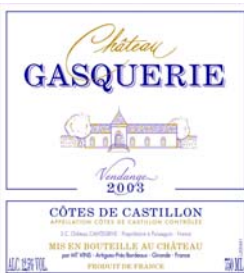

- 19 Craneford Private Selection Shiraz £14.85
An outstanding wine- rich, spicy and full flavoured with a smooth finish
20. McGuigan Bros Black Label Merlot £12.10
Full of plummy fruit, well rounded with a tantalising finish.
21. Wolf Blass Yellow label Cabernet £16.80
A fruit driven Cabernet, manifesting overt blackcurrant fruit, vanilla spice, soft tannins and a wonderfully rounded finish.

22. Domaine de la Citadelle Cabernet £13.95
Fantastic rich and smooth wine. Flavours of blackcurrant and heady forest fruits with a mouth filling finish.
23. Chateau de Gasquere £14.50



90% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc, it is hard to find a wine from this region that offers such quality for its price. Lovely berry fruit pervade the nose and palate with a juicy fruity finish.

24. Guigal Cotes du Rhone £15.75
Crimson purple in colour and full of vibrant fruit with good spice. Cotes du Rhone doesn't get much better than this.
25. Crozes Hermitage Les Pochon £19.35
Smooth and spicy with intense berry fruit characteristics one of the best domaines in the region.
26. Fleurie Domaine Pardon £19.50
This is Cru Beaujolais at its very best. Lovely rich dark berry fruits, warm succulent tannins and oozing fresh spicy flavours.

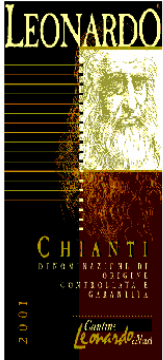

28. Portal del alto Merlot Reserva

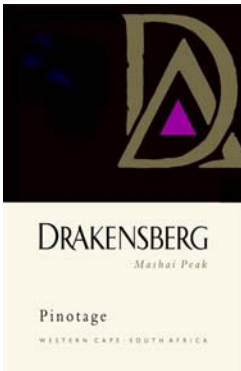
